WHAT WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE NEWSLETTER?

The intent is to send this Newsletter by email regularly reflecting current or coming events or activities within the District or our Local Lodges; Nobel-Monitor, Drott Lodge and Svea Lodge. A summary of some key events or activities will be included in the Newsletter. It will include "buttons" that you can click on for signing-up for the various events or activities.

Our new website will also be continuously updated to show these events and activities, so make sure that you check out our website and the individual lodge websites regularly.

All current Direct Members, Board Members and others related to District #9 will automatically receive our email Newsletters, as long as you have provided a current email address.

OUR NEW MEMBER DATABASE SYSTEM WITH WILD APRICOT

The new software system that we are using for the new websites and this Newsletter is called Wild Apricot, see a description of it below. In addition we will also use Wild Apricot, as our new District #9 member database. As a starting point, we will include information we have about our Direct Members and Board Members; your name and email address into the Wild Apricot CONTACT data base system. The benefit of this is that we can very easily send out emails, like this Newsletter. However, to be included in the MEMBER data base system, you will need a user name and password. If you need assistance getting your membership status organized, Pat will be happy to assign you a password, unique to you, and get you upgraded. (contact her: <u>info@svea-erielodge.org</u>) Being a MEMBER allows you to access the directory of members, Members Only information, and your profile. This system will also permit our Direct Members to easily pay their annual membership dues. (This feature is not yet set up, we will apprise you when this is available.)

WHAT IS WILD APRICOT?

Wild Apricot is web-based software that automates and simplifies the management of the membership of an association like our Lodge and its website.

Wild Apricot consists of several modules that work together:

- membership management
- website (CMS)
- event registration, both free as well as paid for
- online payments coming soon
- emails, e.g. Newsletters
- donations

The Wild Apricot account can be accessed from anywhere with a browser and an Internet connection. If there are volunteers and board members working from home or from different locations, they can all access the same data at the same time without updating and emailing membership lists back and forth.

Through our District #9's Wild Apricot website, the Direct Members and Board Member can access member-only pages, and perform selfservice functions such as updating their membership profile.
