In Norse mythology, a Valkyrie, ("Chooser of the Slain") is one of a host of female figures who guide souls of the dead to the god Odin's hall, named Valhalla. There, the deceased warriors become einherjar (single/or once) fighters. When the einheriar are not preparing for the events of **Ragnarök**, the Valkyrie bear them mead, a beverage of fermented honey. The Valkyries are usually depicted as beautiful maidens riding on horses through the skies over the battlefield. With shrieking cries they swoop down and take their pick of fallen men. They bear the bodies to Valhalla to spend eternity with Odin, waiting Ragnarök. Valkyries also appear as lovers of heroes and other mortals, where they are sometimes

described as the daughters of royalty. They are sometimes accompanied by ravens and sometimes connected to swans.

Ragnarök is a foretold series of impending events, including a great battle in which numerous great Norse mythological figures; the gods Odin,

Thor, <u>Týr</u>, <u>Freyr</u>, <u>Heimdall</u>, and <u>Loki</u>, will perish. Ragnarök will entail a catastrophic series of natural disasters, including the burning of the world, and culminate in the submersion of the world underwater. After these events, the world will rise again, cleansed and fertile, the surviving and returning gods will meet, and the world will be repopulated by two human survivors, <u>Líf and Lífþrasir</u>.
