UPDATE FROM THE 6-7-23 DISTRICT 9 BOARD MEETING

We had to postpone the September meeting but the first order of business will be to come up with a venue for our 2024 Convention that is accessible, yet cost effective. 3 sites are being investigated: Punderson State Park, Geneva On the Lake Conference Center, and Quail Hollow. The 2016 Convention was held at Punderson but the group felt that although it is cost effective, it was not very accessible, even with the elevator. Geneva will not give us a firm quote for our convention more than 11 months out so we have to wait until October to get a quote. No information is available yet for Quail Hollow, they are in the midst of a major renovation and are not open for business. There may be a special executive board meeting to visit the places.

Being in the Cleveland area, possible outside programs could include: wine tours, Abbapalozza, boat tours of Lake Erie, a trip to Rock and Roll Hall of Fame.

Since Wild Apricot has the capabilities to set up conventions, we are hoping to make the registration process available on line.

Svea has presented its updated by-laws to the District Board for approval. Rolf and Bruce will review them to make sure they align with the Grand Lodge Constitution and then the board members will review.
